

executive summary



In 2008 Bahrain International Airport recorded remarkable growth in passenger traffic. Overall passenger movements witnessed an increase of 20% in contrast to 2007 whilst arrivals, departures and transit numbers increased by 20%, 21% and 3% respectively. Transfer passengers reached 4,244,571 with a growth of 29%. The Indian Subcontinent recorded a 45% growth, 33% to South East Asia and 29% within the Middle East & Africa. The Gulf and Europe Regions recorded significant growth of 15% compared to 2007. The Bahrain-Dubai route continues to be the leading route from Bahrain International Airport with 1,096,777 passengers traveling in 2008 against 875,617 in 2007, an outstanding growth of 25% over the year.

Cargo shipments worldwide have however been most influenced by the global financial crisis recording very low levels with an overall decline by 21% worldwide. IATA has predicted that global recovery will take between three to four years. Cargo and mail uplifted and discharged through Bahrain International Airport have also been severely affected by the global recession and recorded declines of -3% and -13% respectively.

Bahrain International Airport is one of the busiest airports in the Gulf region recognized as a key hub linking East and West. Total landings and take-offs movements achieved 101,203 in 2008; an increase of 16% compared to 87,417, a growth of 9% in 2007. Bahrain continues to be considered as an excellent hub for both regional and international carriers.

Despite the global downturn in air traffic, aircraft movements (arrivals, departures and overflying) recorded strong growth of 12% in 2008 compared to 2007. This reflects the overcapacity within the Middle East Region which has yet to match the reduction in traffic.

Although oil prices are again rising to support global demand, BAFCO (Bahrain Aviation Fuel Company) have seen a growth of 14% by supplying 223,090,657 gallons to airlines at BIA in 2008 against 195,633,996 gallons in 2007.

I should like to take this opportunity on behalf of all Civil Aviation Affairs employees and our partners at BIA to convey our sincere gratitude and appreciation to His Excellency Sheikh Ali bin Khalifa Alkhalifa, Deputy Prime Minister for his consistent valuable guidance, support and encouragement so as to enable us to maintain our performance in line with our reputation as leaders in aviation in the region.

PASSENGERS

Arriving Passengers (Arrivals)

All passengers who land at an airport and pass through immigration.

Departing Passengers (Departures)

All passengers who pass through immigration prior to departure from the airport.

Disembarking Passengers

All passengers who disembark from an aircraft, including transfer passengers but excluding transit.

Embarking Passengers

All passengers who board an aircraft, including those who have transferred from other aircraft, but excluding transit.

Transfer Passengers

Passengers flying into and out of an airport on a different aircraft, or on the same aircraft bearing different flight numbers, and whose main purpose for using the airport was to effect a transfer.

Direct Transit Passengers

Passengers stopping temporarily at the designated airport and departing on the same aircraft in which they arrived, bearing the same aircraft registration and flight number.

Total Passengers

 $All\ passengers-arrivals/departures/transit/transfer\ i.e.\ all\ disembarking/embarking\ and\ transit.$

FREIGHT

Mail

Is the weight of letter mail carried.

Cargo

Is a flight carrying solely freight and/or mail and associated cargo attendants.

MOVEMENTS

Aircraft Movements

An aircraft take-off or landing at an airport. For airport traffic purposes one arrival and one departure is counted as two movements.

Commercial Movements

Landings or take-offs of aircraft engaged in the transport of passengers, cargo or mail on commercial terms.

Military Movements

Movements exclusively for military purposes using military aircraft.

Private Movements

Movements for purely non-commercial purposes by private owners or other private aircraft operators.


Bahrain International Airport's performance in 2008 has shown significant results which are reflected in the optimistic growth rates. Passenger traffic reached 8.7 million compared to 7.3 million in 2007, with a growth of 20% and average growth of 11% over the last ten years. Transfer passengers achieved 29% growth reaching 4.2 million passengers compared to 3.3 million to previous year.

As Bahrain is recognized as "The Airport of Choice" by many airlines, this resulted in a growth of 16% in arriving and departing aircraft in contrast to 2007. An average growth of 7% has also recorded over the period since 1999.

Flight Information Region movements are continuously rising and have reached 452,246, with a growth of 12% compared to 402,697 in 2007, with an average growth of 11% over the last ten years.

Cargo and mail figures however declined due to the worldwide economic crisis. Total cargo shipments carried via Bahrain International Airport reached 332,798 tonnes 3% lower than 2007 yet maintained an average growth of 11% for the last ten years. Mail reduced by 13% during 2008 reaching 37,909 tonnes. However, total mail tonnes recorded an average growth of 33% over the last ten years.

Total fuel sales in 2008 of 223,090,657 gallons achieved 14% growth in comparison to 195,633,996 gallons sold in 2007 which has led to an average growth of 8% for the last decade.

Total Passengers by Region 2008



Total Passengers by Airline and Destination 2008

Passengers are at the heart of any airport. In 2008 embarked and disembarked passengers in Bahrain contributed to 48% of the total passengers. The remaining passengers (representing 52% of the total passengers) used Bahrain as a hub transiting or transferring to other destinations.

Airlines operating at Bahrain International Airport served 52 destinations during 2008. Dubai was the top destination with 1,096,777 passengers recording a growth of 25% over 2007. Other major destinations were Doha, London, Kuwait, Abu Dhabi, Riyadh, Manila, Mumbai, Jeddah and Cairo.


Regionally, the Indian Subcontinent achieved a spectacular growth of 45% with Mumbai being the leading destination, reaching 273,704 passengers and recording a growth of 29% compared to 2007. South East Asia also recorded healthy growth with an increase of 33%, with Manila as the main destination achieving a growth rate of 38% above 2007. In the Middle East and Africa Region 29% growth was achieved compared to 2007. Cairo was the busiest destination scoring 230,736 passengers compared to 209,918 in 2007. Both the Gulf and European Regions achieved a growth of 15% against 2007. Dubai and London were the leading destinations showing a growth of 25% and 22% respectively.





Total Passengers by Airline and Destination 2008 - North and South East Asia





The number of aircraft movements operated through Bahrain International Airport was 101,203 in 2008 compared to 87,417 movements in 2007, with a 16% growth rate. Passenger flights contributed to 76% of the total movements, where cargo, private and other flights contributed to 14%, 1% and 9% respectively.

The main aircraft types handled via Bahrain International Airport were A320 achieving 29,045 movements followed by A330-200 reaching 10,052, A340-300 at 8,909, B737-800 at 7,462 and B727-200 with 5,834 movements.





Total Cargo Throughput by Airline 2008



Due to the global economic crisis, almost all sectors were badly affected. The cargo sector in the aviation business was severely affected worldwide. Bahrain International Airport recorded a 3% decline in cargo where the total tonnes carried reached 332,798 compared to 341,630 in 2007.

Total mail carried declined by 13% to 37,909 tonnes in 2008 against 43,648 tonnes in 2007.

DHL International B.S.C. was the leading airline in cargo operations at Bahrain International Airport with 42% of the market followed by Gulf Air with 22%.



Bahrain International Airport works closely with all Government authorities concerned, one of which is the Ministry of Interior who provide monthly statistics of passengers embarking and disembarking in the Kingdom of Bahrain.

Immigration figures have shown significant growth of 13% where passengers reached 4,166,871 measured up to 3,681,610 in 2007.

Top three nationalities were Indians representing 19% of total passengers, Bahraini and Saudi nationals represented 18% and 9% respectively.

Immigration statistics by country showed that passengers arriving to and departing from Bahrain were mainly from United Arab Emirates corresponding to 23% of total passengers. The next most significant numbers were from India at 15% and from Qatar at 8%.
