#### **Important Information**

1. It is the user's responsibility to check its content revision status for currency against any revised legislation. Legislation content applicable to this version can be found at www.BCAA.gov.au/fatigue

#### **Purpose of the Form**

1. The purpose of the Form is to assist an Applicant in the development of their FRMS, provide and receive communication with BCAA during the FRMS development. However, it is the applicant's ultimate responsibility to ensure their documentation submission and their FRMS comply with the requirements and achieve the safety outcomes required whether or not the compliance elements are asked for in this Form.

#### **Navigating the Form**

Different sections of the Form can be accessed via the Tabs located at the bottom of the spreadsheet window:

This Instructions page is the first tab; the second tab (blue tab) is the FRMS Checklist.

The third tab is the Communication History (orange tab) where additional information in relation to the application, comments and feedback will be recorded.

#### Entering information in the FRMS Checklist tab Applicant

Only enter status and progress information in the 'Applicant use only' section of the form.

- FRMS Manual Reference: Identify relevant references in the FRMS Manual which specifically address
  each requirement or indicate where the information may be found. List multiple references if the
  requirement is met over multiple parts of the documentation. The more specific the reference, the
  quicker the assessment process.
- 2. **Applicant's FRMS Documentation Status:** The applicant should select one of 'In Progress, Final, Updated or N/A based on the following criteria.

#### Table 1.

In Progress	The documentation that addresses this requirement is still being developed and not ready for assessment
Final	The applicant believes the documentation that addresses this requirement is final and ready for assessment
Updated	The documentation was marked as final however has now been updated and is again ready for assessment
N/A	This option is available in the case of 'supplemental information' if the applicant has a different approach

3. **Applicant's Assessment of Implementation Progress:** The Applicant has 3 options for indicating whether a requirement has been met in the documentation: Not Present, Present Not Yet Suitable, and Present and Suitable. Once the Applicant determines that the requirement is met in the documentation and suitable for their organisation then they can indicate if it is operational and appears capable, and finally that it is proving to be effective.

#### **BCAA Inspector**

Only enter feedback information in the 'BCAA use only - Status is a recommendation only - Assessment is subject to Peer Review' section of the form.

- 1. The BCAA inspector should split the assessment up into a document or desktop assessment and a verification assessment that may require site visits and/or the assessment of samples, data and
- 2. BCAA Documentation Assessment: Where the Applicant has indicated that the line item is at a 'Final' or 'Updated' status the inspector should indicate whether the line item has been assessed.
  - For the documentation assessment the options are in Table 3. below.

To Be Assessed	Use this is selection to keep track of those lines you have not assessed as yet.
Assessment Conducted	This indicates that the inspector has assessed the line item at the document stage and therefore there should be an assessment result in the next column.
Other - See Notes	Use this to direct the applicant to the notes e.g. if the inspector discontinues the assessment because of the low standard of the material or because the requirement has been misunderstood. Add details in the notes line below or communation tab if required.

- 3. The options for the Documentation Assessment are: Not Present, Present Not Yet Suitable, and Present and Suitable, with the description the same as Table 2. above.
- 4. BCAA Implementation Verification: Where the Applicant has indicated that the line item is at a 'Final' or 'Updated' status and the inspector has completed the documentation assessment, the inspector should indicate whether the item has been verified or validation has been scheduled.

For the implementation verification assessment the options are: Schedule Verification, Verification Conducted, and Other -See Notes.

Schedule Verification	The Applicant needs to schedule an opportunity to verify that this requirement meets the Trial or Full approval standard
Verification Conducted	The inspector has verified that the required standard has been met and therefore there should be an assessment result in the next
Other - See Notes	Use this to direct the applicant to the notes line below or Communication Tab

- 5. The options for the Implementation Verification are: Not Yet Capable, Appears Reasonably Capabel, and Effective, with the description of these the same as Table 2. above.
- 6. **Status Assessed/ Verified Final or Updated:** In this cell the inspector indicates whether the version they assessed had been identified as 'Final' or 'Updated' by the Applicant.
- 7. **Date of Last Assessment/Verification (DD/MM/YYYY):** Enter the date on which the line item was last assessed in the required format. If this date is before the commencement of the trial the background will remain white however when this date is after the date of the commencement of the trial (once entered next to 'Approved Trial Commencement Date' at the top of the Form), the background will change to grey. This aids in quickly seeing which assessments were undertaken before the trial commenced and which have been conducted during the trial.
- 8. Standard Required for BCAA Implementation Approval: These cells are set and cannot be adjusted by the applicant or inspector.

#### **Notes Lines**

Text can be added by either the Applicant or the inspector in the 'notes' row below each line item. The height of the 'notes' row can be adjusted to ensure all text remains visible. The cursor needs to be placed below the 'Applicant Notes:' or 'BCAA Notes:' to enable editing.

#### **Supplemental information**

In the FRMS Checklist cells, Supplemental information refers to information that may need to be presented to BCAA to ensure an element of the FRMS is accomplished and within a supportable framework in accordance with subclause 8.1 of Appendix 7. It is in-effect, setting out an acceptable means of compliance or partial compliance and therefore, an alternate means would be acceptable if the required outcome was achieved. A specific reference to a subclause, paragraph or subparagraph is provided when the acceptable means of compliance refers to a specific requirement.

#### **Process**

- 1. The form must be updated and submitted by the applicant with every amendment or update to the FRMS and supporting documents to facilitate review by a BCAA inspector.
- 2. Each version of this document submitted to BCAA must be controlled by being given a new version number by the Applicant, e.g. Version 1.0, 2.0, 3.0 etc. in the 'Submission version number' box in the top righthand corner.
- 3. The date in the top righthand corner must be updated by the Applicant with the date that the Form was updated and submitted to BCAA. This date should be written into the 'Submission Date' box and in the format DD/MM/YYYY.
- 4. The Applicant can add any notes below each line that they believe it is important the inspector be aware of. More extensive comment should be inputted on the 'Communications' tab. Where the applicant has placed comments etc, in the communication tab wite 'see communications tab' in the notes section under the applicable line.
- 5. A BCAA Assessor will review the submission and return the form to the applicant with a recommended assessment status, indicating the areas that require changing or action from the applicant and providing feedback in the notes section below each line or in the Communication History Tab which the Applicant may need to address. Where the assessor has placed notes, or comment etc, in the communication tab 'see communications tab' will be annotated in the notes section under the
- 6. For each line, once the document assessment has been conducted, the inspector may select 'Schedule Verification', in the 'BCAA Implementation Verification', 'Status' column indicating to the Applicant that they should contact the Inspector to arrange an opportunity to verify that the requirement is being met at either the Trial or Full implementation standard (as applicable).
- 7. For each line, the inspector should also input the version that was assessed i.e., 'Final' or 'Updated' and then in the next column, the date that this assessment was conducted.
- 8. The Inspector then saves the version in TRIM and returns a copy to the applicant.
- 9. If the applicant changes their documentation and selects 'Updated' as the status the BCAA inspector assessments will change to having an orange background indicating these assessments need to be reviewed.

#### **Traffic Light Indicators**

The following traffic light indicators located in the FRMS Checklist tab provide a quick reference of the assessment results. The colour in the Applicant's side is dependant on whether the Applican't assessment is at the standard required for Trial or Full FRMS approval. The colour on the BCAA side is dependant on whether the BCAA inspector is recommending whether the Applicant meets the standard for Trial or Full approval.

Red - not at the required standard and changes are required

Yellow - schedule verification - Applicant will need to schedule verification with BCAA

Orange - Operator has updated this line since the last BCAA assessment and it is yet to be reassessed or verified by the BCAA assessor

Green - Ready for Trial or Ready for full implementation. The column header indicates whether it is trial or full standard that is being applied
