Aviation Safety & Security Directive 1/17

Operation of Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAV)

It is hereby expressly forbidden to operate an Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV), sometimes known as a "drone", within the Kingdom of Bahrain, unless prior permission has been received from the Bahrain Civil Aviation Affairs.

Applications to operate a UAV shall be made in writing 7 working days prior to the intended date of operation and shall include:

- 1. The scope of the operation,
- 2. The name and details of the person or persons intending to operate the UAV,
- 3. Insurance cover details for the operation,
- 4. No objection evidence from the Ministry of the Interior, Bahrain Defence Force, and any other concerned authority.
