TRANSPORTATION OF RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL FROM/TO/THROUGH BAHRAIN INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

The transportation of radioactive material from/to/through (via) Bahrain International Airport requires prior permission, which must be obtained from the Civil Aviation Affairs (CAA) of the Kingdom of Bahrain (refer Article 14 of the Civil Aviation Law).

Permission to transport radioactive material must be obtained separately for each consignment by using this form. Under exceptional circumstances, requests for carriage of the radioactive material may be considered for approval by Civil Aviation Affairs when:

- The radioactive material is transported in accordance with ICAO Technical Instructions for the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air (Doc 9284-AN/905);
- the operator gives an undertaking that the radioactive material is packed, marked and labelled in accordance with ICAO Annex 18 and ICAO Technical Instructions as stated above;
- copy of the Shipper's Declaration (DGD) must be attached with this application;
- In case of import, copy of the import licence issued by the Supreme Council of Environment.
- the applications are made at least **three working days** in advance of the proposed date of transportation to the Civil Aviation Affairs, at the following address:

Notes on Completion of the Form:

- The Operator (Airline) is required to complete the application form ASSD-OF-10-DGR (Rev. 0 -7th October'2018)) providing all details in CAPITAL letters/Uppercase.
- The Operator (Airline) must ensure that the goods are within the limitations of the Dangerous Goods Regulations and are packed, marked, labelled and documented in accordance with the Technical Instructions (ICAO Doc. 9284-AN/905).

Changes in flight arrangements

Any changes to planned flight arrangements must be notified to the Civil Aviation Affairs and their approval shall be obtained. This may be done by completing a fresh application form with new flight details and sending the same either by email or fax, with a copy of the previous approval for the consignment, to the Civil Aviation Affairs, on the above given fax number or to dq.caa@mtt.gov.bh

Changes to consignment

If any changes are made to the contents of a consignment, e.g. a change in items, quantity, weight per package, etc., for which a CAA approval had previously been granted, the approval will no longer be valid for that consignment, and a fresh application must be submitted.
